

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC 4TH AND 5TH GRADES

Instrumental music lessons will be offered two times per week to Williams 4th and 5th grade students after school on Tuesday and Thursday. The classes will be taught by a retired instrumental music teacher who is a grandparent of two students at Williams. Classes to be taught are: violin, flute, clarinet, saxophone (for 5th graders, only), trumpet, and trombone. All classes are for beginners, though students who have previously studied their instrument may participate at the beginner level. The classes will be 30 minutes in length and will commence 5 minutes after dismissal at 30 minute intervals.

An introductory session will be given in the cafeteria on Thursday, September 8th at 3:05 pm in the cafeteria. Students will gain an understanding of the instruments and may ask questions concerning this music program.
